Scenic Tour Information

Lake Crescent Backroads (Guided tour)

ATDI Poker run is back! Join us for a tour of beautiful backroads near Lake Crescent and Agate Beach, a blast from the past at the Joyce General store (the general store first opened in 1911, making it the longest continually operating general store in Washington), lunch at Log Cabin Resort at Lake Crescent, and check your poker hand at the Camaraderie Winery. Under 60 miles round trip with frequent stops.

Sequim Backroads (Guided tour)

This tour will be led by Andrew Loehr, a native of Sequim, who has driven the area's back roads for many years. We'll start by visiting the Sequim Cars and Coffee event. Then we're on to enjoy seeing farm country, an active dairy with home made ice cream, Marine Drive with amazing views of the Pacific, Mount Baker, and Victoria, Dungeness Spit, as well as the historic Carlsborg Mercantile store built in 1915 and lunch at the Carlsborg Old Mill Cafe. Under 60 round trip miles with stop opportunities along the way.

Hurricane Ridge (Guided tour)

Take the iconic drive to Hurricane Ridge with magnificent views to reward you at the top and along the way. It provides the only vehicle access to the remote high country of the Olympic National Park and has an elevation of 4,242 feet. Look out at 6,900 foot Mt Olympus, the highest peak in the Olympics! The drive is 40 miles round trip.



For this tour, you must get your National Park pass in advance.

The Olympic National Park website shows the pass options. A seven day pass for a car is \$30.00. If you are 62 or older, you can purchase an annual pass to all the National Parks for \$20! If you have one already, don't forget to put it in the glove box!

Ediz Hook (Self-guided tour)

Ediz Hook is a three-mile long peninsula that offers stunning views of the Olympic Mountains, the Strait of Juan de Fuca and the city of Port Angeles. You can drive, walk or bike the first 2-miles along this spit, before turning around at the Coast Guard Base at the end of the spit (the final mile is not open to visitors). There are two parks at Ediz Hook: the Sail and Paddle Park, and Harborview Park, with plenty of benches and picnic tables to enjoy the glorious views. It's less than a mile away from the Red Lion so an easy short outing.
